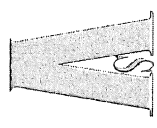

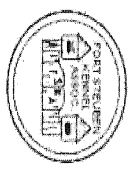

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

A RECORDING FEE of \$.50 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, obedience trial or tracking test. The Event Service fee of \$3.00 is collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapt. II, Sec. 2.)
